We will be closed every OTHER Saturday and always closed on Sundays.



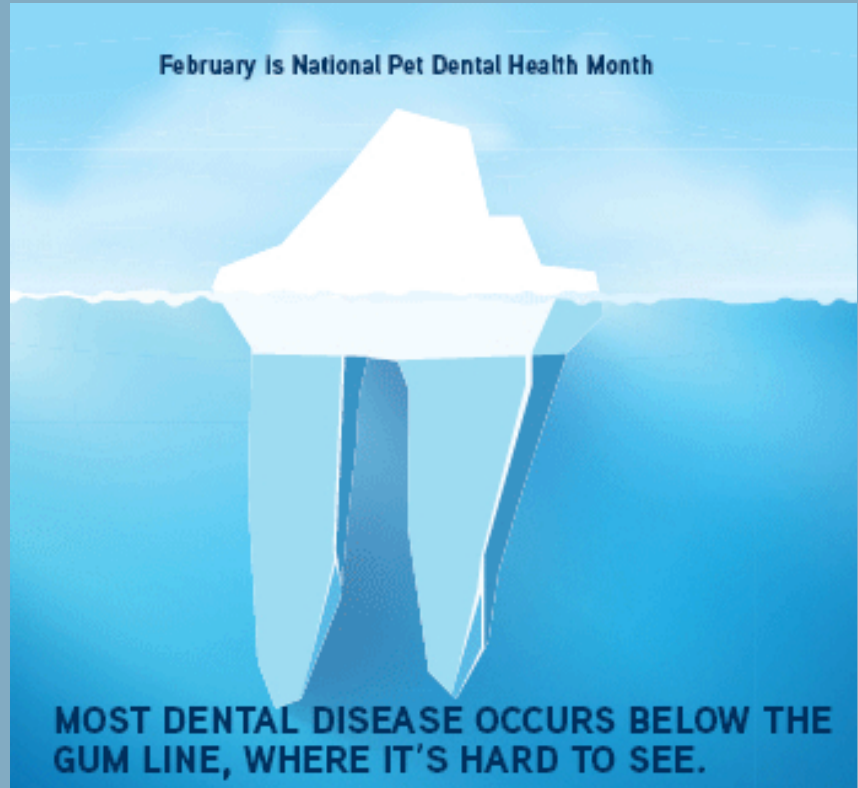
Now is a great time to bell train your pet to signal you whenever they have to go outside! But how does it work?



1. Get your pet familiar with the bells. Leave them hanging by the door and whenever it's time to go potty, walk them over to the bells and as soon as they touch it with their nose, give a lot of praise and a treat.
2. Once they're familiar with the bells, continue to be firm about your pet NEEDING to ring the bells whenever they'd like to go outside.
3. Consistency is key. Always use word commands, make sure they only use the bell for potty time, and never withhold rewards.

February is PAWS dental month!

Dental health is a very important part of your pet's overall health, and dental problems can cause, or be caused by, other health problems. Your pet's teeth and gums should be checked at least once a year by your veterinarian to check for early signs of a problem and to keep your pet's mouth healthy. Unlike humans, cats and dogs cannot brush their teeth everyday so even preventative dentals can completely recourse the condition of your pet's teeth and future!
