STATE-OF-THE-ART TECHNOLOGY

Your veterinarian will do a complete physical examination on your pet the morning of their procedure.

This examination is vital to rule out any changes in the heart, lungs, etc. **before** your pet undergoes anesthesia.

Our surgery team strives to provide the **best patient** care possible. We treat our patients like our own pets.

From cuddling pets after they are dropped off in the morning, to comforting patients who are recovering from surgery, our technicians are always giving a little extra TLC. We believe that makes all the difference.

A trained surgery technician will be dedicated to care for your pet throughout the entire surgery.

During the procedure, AND this technician's sole responsibility is to monitor your pet while under anesthesia and to collaborate with the doctor to ensure the health and safety of your pet.

PAWS is proud to offer state-of-the-art anesthetic monitoring equipment. This technoloy helps the surgeon and anesthetist determine health status and anesthetic depth while your pet is in surgery.

Thanks to this technology, we are able to monitor:

SPO2 **Blood Pressure** Pulse (Doppler) ECG Temperature EtCO2

POST-SURGERY UPDATES KEEPING YOU IN THE LOOP

When your pet is being prepared for surgery, an IV Catheter will be placed.

This is an essential step, not only to allow IV Fluid Therapy, but it allows immediate access to the circulatory system, if additional medications are needed.

REGULATING YOUR PET'S VITALS

Your pet will be on IV Fluid Therapy for the entirety of the surgical procedure and throughout the recovery process. AND

A dedicated technician will recover your pet after waking from anesthesia.

Your pet will recover in one of our thermal recovery cages with their technician monitoring vital signs and keeping them comfortable.

AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS

POST-SURGERY RECHECK ANSWERING ALL YOUR QUESTIONS CONTINUING CARE WHILE YOUR PET HEALS

When you pick up your pet after surgery, the surgery technician and doctor will meet with you to review aftercare instructions.

NO NEED TO TAKE NOTES, WE DO ALL THE WRITING FOR YOU.

You will go home with a printed copy of the instuctions that are customized for your pet. A technician will evaluate your pet during the healing process, answer any questions, and remove sutures at this visit, at no charge to you.

This technician appointment will be scheduled at time of discharge from surgery.
