Summer is back and the heat is on! It's important to remember the risks our pets are at with the rising Arizona temperatures. One of them being pavement temps! Tucson is known for it's dog-walking-community, unfortunately, summer really dictates the amount of time spent outside for our furry loved ones. Studies have shown pavement can reach 40-60 degrees higher than the temperature outside! And Arizona has know to hit the triple digits all summer long.

Shoes are a great option for pets who still want to enjoy the great outdoors while protecting their feetsies! But remember, the hottest parts of the day occur between 10am-3pm. It's always better to enjoy your walks early morning or late afternoon. Cooling vests are a wonderful option as well! Both available on Amazon. The more you can do to protect your pet, the better.



Is your pet experiencing dehydration? Here are the signs to look out for!

- lack of appetite
- lethargy/weakness
- dark colored urine
- excessive panting
- sunken eyes
- tacky/dry gums
- loss of skin elasticity
- dry nose

## July is national pet hydration month!

It's a dry heat...keep pets hydrated! Dogs need approximately I ounce of water per pound of body weight each day, while cats need 3.5-4.5 ounces per 5 pounds of body weight. While it's always advisable to have fresh eater available, adding some of these items to your pet's daily diet may help ensure they're hydrated!

Answers - Fish and Turkey stock, raw fermented goat's milk & cow kefir

NutriSource - Come-Poocha -shelf stable bone broth

OC Raw - Raw goat's milk and flavored goat's milk

Open Farm - Bone broth (Beef, turkey, and chicken all shelf-stable)

Primal - frozen raw goat's milk (original, cranberry, pumpkin, and green goodness), Frozen Bone broth (Beef, Pork, Turkey, and chicken all frozen).

Smallbatch - shelf-stable and frozen bone broths

Solutions - Frozen goat's milk (Better Butter Tea/Tummy Butter Tea/Goat Nog Goat milk/ Pork, Chicken, Fish Jiggles

Stella & Chewy's - shelf-stable Broth Toppers

The Honest Kitchen - Bone broth Pour Overs (beef, chicken, turkey/salmon), Instant Goat's Milk packets, shelf-stable bone broth, Daily Boosters Beef Bone Broth)
